What is The Christina Noble Children's Foundation Social Enterprise Programme?

- **The Christina Noble Children's Foundation Social Enterprise Programme** is designed to empower third level students to create and execute their own fundraising projects to raise money for the Christina Noble Children's Foundation.
- 100 students are chosen from applicants and commit to raising a minimum of €500 in 60 days.
- Each student is matched with a professional mentor who can help support them throughout their fundraising projects and who will bring valuable experience and a great network.
- Students will develop professional skills such as project management, networking and communication skills, and will gain practical experience that will help them gain access to jobs in their future chosen careers.

Who should apply?

- Anyone who is passionate about meeting and working with Ireland's upcoming talent, and is in a particular field such as Marketing, Business, Media and Events Management.
- It is recommended that mentors that apply are flexible enough to commit to 1-2 hours per week. These hours will be used to connect either in person, by phone, or by email, with their student on a one to one basis to discuss and guide them on their chosen events.
- Students will have the opportunity to shadow their Mentors for one day.

Why should Mentors apply?

- Mentors will gain insights into the upcoming generation of talent who will soon be flooding in to the workplace.
- To meet potential internship students.
- To build a network of students and professionals that can help and support you now and in future years to come.
- You will be supporting a fantastic charity and will become part of a growing movement for change.
